

ROCK OF AGES RESCUE CENTRE PICTORIAL EXPLANATION:

Rock of Ages Rescue Centre has areas that need more expansion and that make us feel we need more space for expansion. These areas are covered as follows;



We need a modern gate to the Rescue Centre. The present one is outdated and somehow not in good condition. We lack finances and means to make it. You can be blessed to make it for us. God bless you



This is the exterior part of the gate. The road leading to it is also in a messy state and need be done. The ground is rocky.



Part of the fence from the exterior front of the gate. This fence is made of twigs and shrubs because we are financially unstable to allow us be in position to make the fence as needed.



Part of the fence made with old corrugated iron sheets. We have only this one tank as both a reservoir and a main source of water for our domestic use. We need another or more tanks.



A very stony and rough ground that need be cemented and leveled for easy movement and playing by the children, caregivers and the visitors.



A rest ground that mostly is used by children to study and do their home works. It is part of the rocky and rough ground and lacks shades to shield them from direct sunlight. We need smoothened and shielded



An overview of the kitchen used to prepare meals for the children and the caregivers. The kitchen is made of Makeshifts and old iron sheets Landscaping is done by us. The flowers form live fence.



One of the two point where water is collected. This pipe feeds the reservoir which is the only source of water. The piped water comes only once in a week and is provided by the County Government of Nairobi. We pay the bills monthly.



The available ground for washing in front of toilets and near the tank. This is the only place where grass has been maintained because other places are rocky. However, we have planted some trees and flowers that grow on rocky grounds.



Part of the building serving as a dormitory for boys, and a store. The house adjacent serves as a home for one caregiver and her family and part of it as an office

The land yonder is not ours but borders us behind the building. However, we are given a section to farm it. We do not get enough food from it because it is very small.



The only washrooms serving us as toilets and bathrooms. Beside and behind them are corrugated iron sheets fences that serve as a border for the land we are in and other pieces of land



Improvised hand washing cans through recycled jericans and polythene sacks. The water for hand washing is put in the cans and one washes through the pipes affixed to the cans. The water that flows is collected under the flowers for watering them up



One of the children washing his hands after visiting the toilet. This maintains good sanitation and checks health wise of the children in this rescue centre. The water is used together with a soap suspended by the red net aside.



Part of the boys' dormitories. The Arrangement of beds is done in a way to help in the economizing of the available space. This dormitory is very much squeezed is the only one available. You can support us for expansion.



A shoe rack in the boys' dormitory This shoe rack serves all the boys even though their shoes cannot be comfortable kept there. You can find them being squeezed, stuffed up and folded to fit in the rack. We have a need in this and beddings.



Slightly above the shoe rack is shelf like structure for keeping their clothes. They all use this shelf to keep their clothes both uniform and civilians. The space is also not enough for keeping all clothes but is better than none.



The only available book shelf in the boys' dormitory where they keep their books. Some of the books are kept on top of the shelf because the space is not enough for all boys. We need help too.



Part of the girls' dormitory showing a bed for the youngest girls
The dormitory is much squeezed and the spacing of beds not as needed. We are stretched more than we can afford and therefore, use the available space.



Part of another side of the girls' dormitory. As explained earlier the dormitory is much squeezed and any available space is used for setting up beds and items that can support the children.
